Additionally, employees may be granted up to four hours of administrative leave **per leave year** to volunteer (unpaid) as non-partisan poll workers or non-partisan observers for those elections.

Employees who wish to use administrative leave for this purpose must coordinate their schedule in advance with their supervisor.
